The dispensing balance consists of a simple, light but rigid, equal-armed horizontal beam with central and terminal knife-edges The beam turns about the central fulcrum under the influence of the loads placed on pans suspended from the terminal knife-edges The oscillations of the beams are dampened to allow readings to be made quickly and easily
